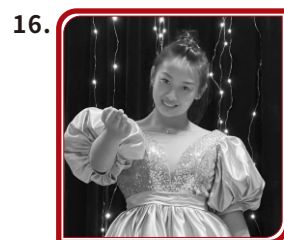
14. **Yap Zhi Yu Tasha, Harp**

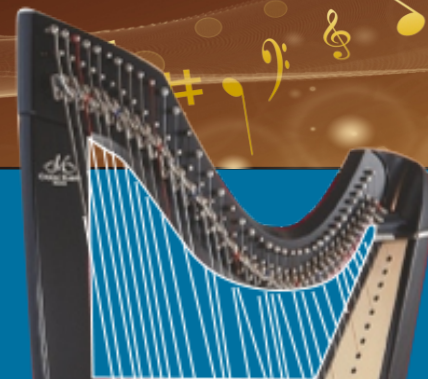
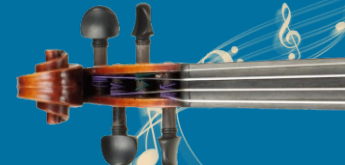
